a hut or lair: - booth, cottage, covert, pavilion, tabernacle, tent.



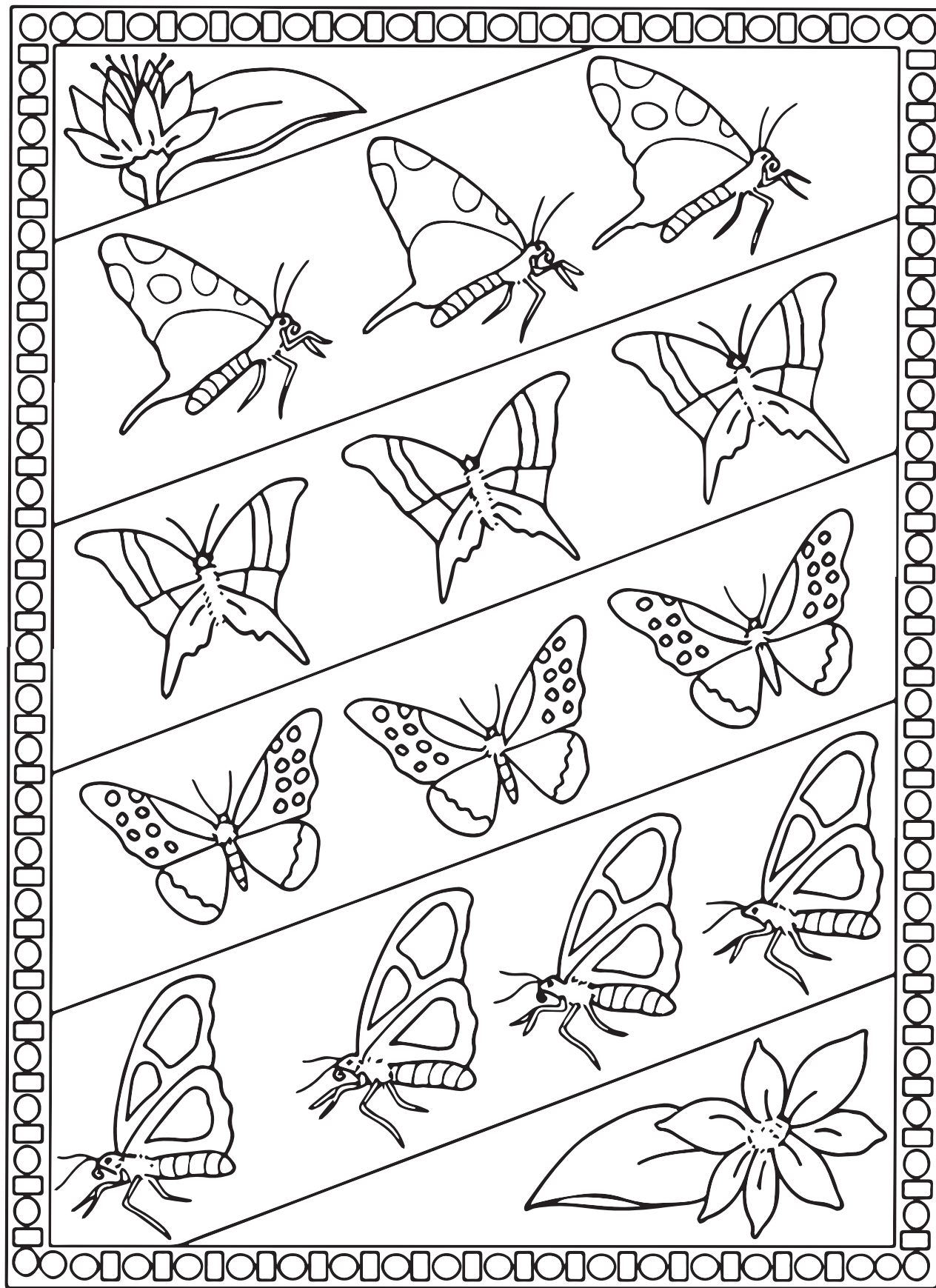

 Missouri: Parrosaurus, a small tyrannosaurid (perhaps Albertosaurus), hadrosaurs (duck-billed dinosaurs)

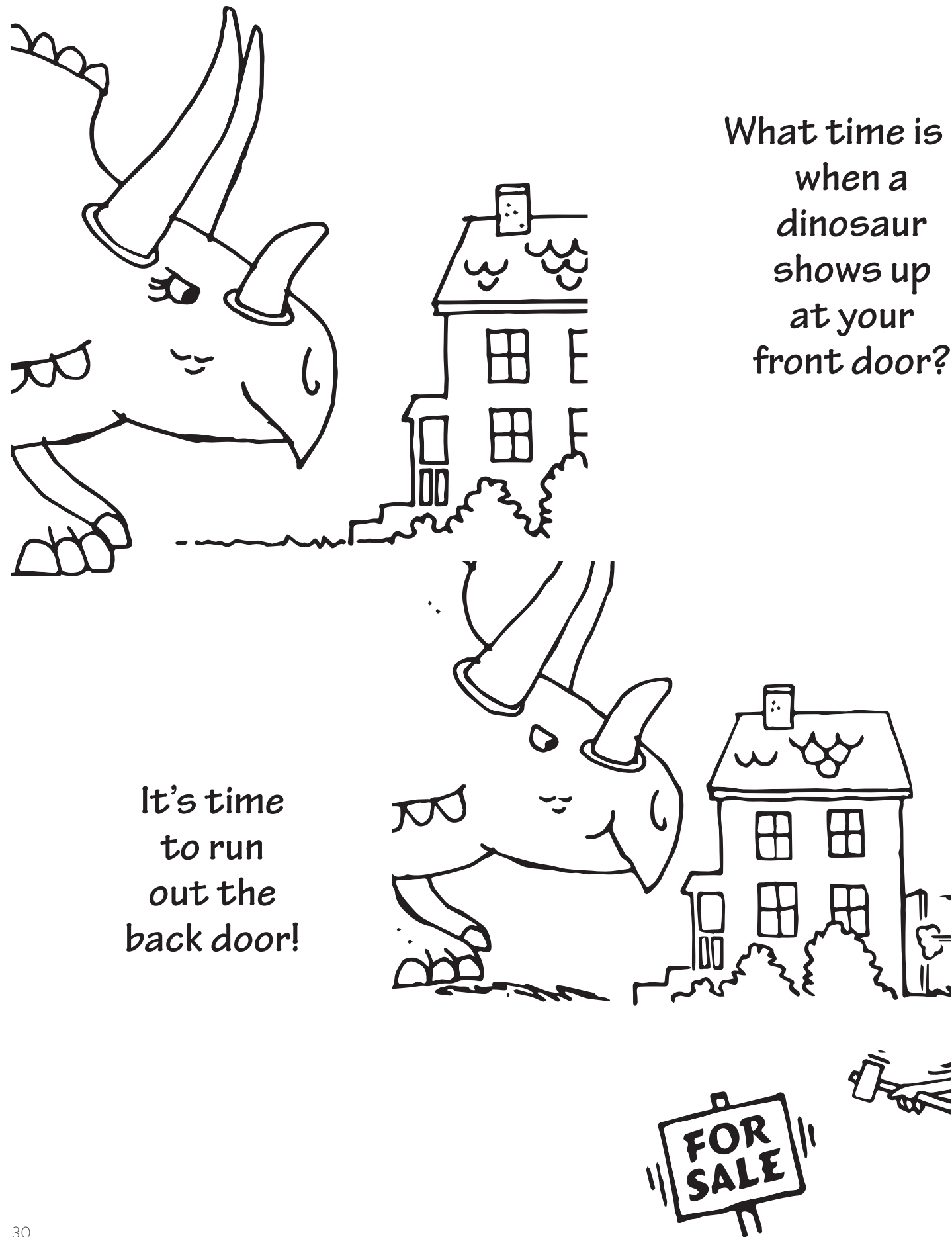

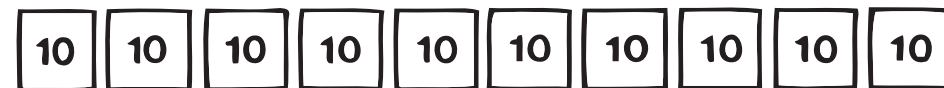
